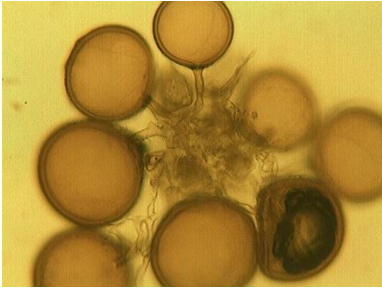


Transfer of fungal lineages



The CRB-JD performs transfer of fungal lineages of free access to national and international institutions in accordance with current legislation that deals with the transportation and delivery of genetic material. The transfer is documented by a delivery note and signature of the Material Transfer Agreement (MTA) of the Brazilian genetic heritage. The MTA should be signed by Embrapa Agrobiologia and the requesting research institution.

Some fungal lineages are available for immediate delivery, but others only with previous multiplication (some months in the case of Glomeromycota).

The term lineages is used here as a synonym of strain, isolate or access. The term is defined as the monospecific set of descendants of a mycorrhizal fungus isolation, not necessarily one monosporic isolation.

How to request the transfer of fungal lineages?

Note: there may be availability of other unlisted fungal lineages to be consulted also by email.

2. Forward the transfer request to cnpab.crbjd.pedidos@embrapa.br as agreed by previous contact (Step 1).

3. Upon receipt of the request, we will contact you with information about the necessary documentation and costs for the transfer of the fungal lineages.
